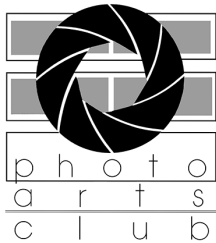

Matting and Mounting Your Photography

Mounting Materials

These mounting materials are available most places such as; B&H, Hobby Lobby, Michaels, Warehouse Craft Supplies, framing stores as well as art stores such as The Art Supply Depo.

- Archival Foam Core Board
- Mounting Squares
- Hinge Tape
- Double –Sided Tape
- Permanent Photo Tabs
- Photo Corners 1 1/4”
- 3M Super 77 spray adhesive

Make sure any materials that you use are archival.

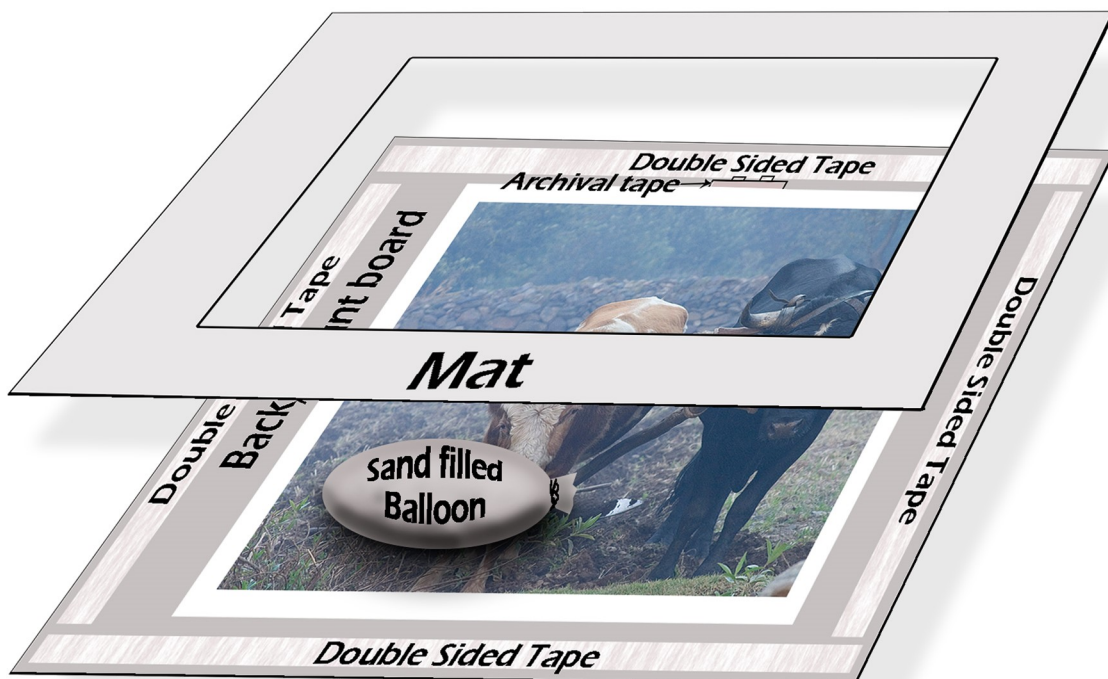

Matting and Mounting



There are more than one way to mat or mount your finished photo.

I am going to share my way of matting prints.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

A backboard

A mat

A finished Print

roll of Archival tape

A roll of 2 sided Carpet Tape

A balloon filled with sand

to get started, cut strips of 2 sided carpet tape. Measure the strips to be the length of the longest side and the shortest side. I then cut the tape in half lengthwise. This gives you tape for all four sides Set these aside, leaving the cover on.

Set your print on the backboard and set the mat over the print. Position your print to get the most pleasing area inside of the mat. (This is actual another way of cropping) When you find the best position, set the sand filled balloon on the print. Remove the mat.

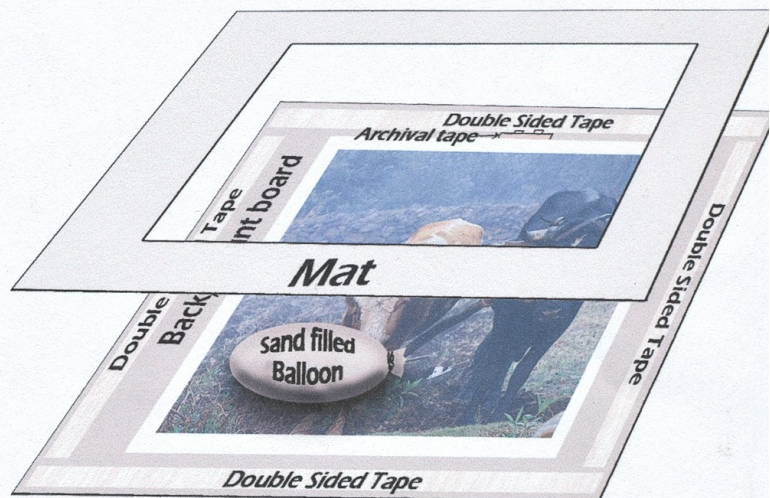
With the Archival tape, cut two short pieces of tape and one longer strip. Attach the two short pieces to the top center back of the print being careful to not move print. Now, attach the longer strip of tape over the two smaller strips that are already attached to your print. This attaches the print to the backboard. This creates a floating of your print, which allows you to remove print or shift if needed. Set top mat over the print to make sure that it has not moved.

If satisfied with positioning. Attach the stripes of Carpet tape to the sides of your backboard. Remove the over cover of the tape.

The tricky part taking the backboard and mat, carefully line up the mat and backboard together by setting up on end on hard surface but not touching. Tap to make sure the print is where you want it to be. Attach the front mat to the backboard.

You are now set for framing.

I learned this method from Craft 2000 in Monroe, MI

2023 Annual Contest Recap

We received 723 entries from 146 photographers, basically doubling the participation we have received in previous years. Following is the breakdown by category:

We received 46 responses (31%) from our photographer survey with mostly positive ratings and comments. On a scale of 1 to 10 we averaged over 7. By far the largest complaint was concerning the reception. We had too many folks respond for the space at the Secor Center. The committee has already met to identify how to improve next year’s contest.

The exhibit remains open on Saturdays and Sundays from Noon to 4 pm until May 6th. Photographers are expected to pick up their entries between Noon and 4 pm on Sunday, May 7th. Voting continues for People’s Choice until April 16th.
