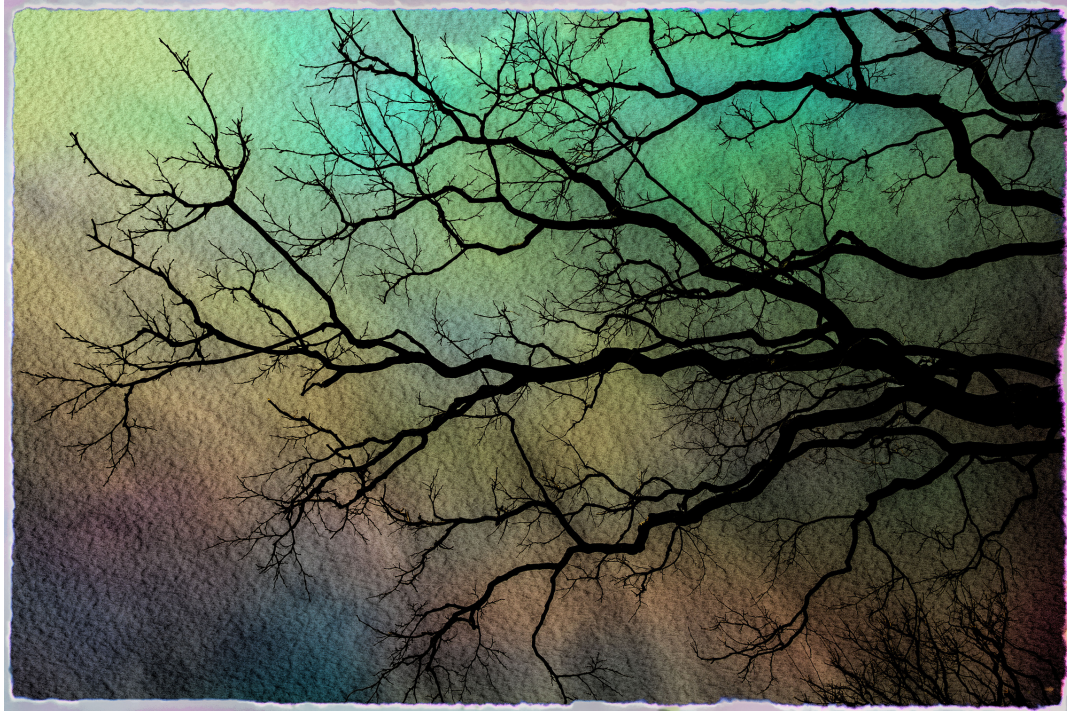
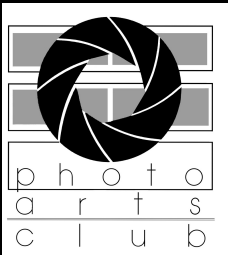

Here is the Criteria:

Framed Photo Art is limited to 4 pieces per member.

Works must be family friendly as they are displayed in a very public area.

Frames must be no larger than 26”h x 36”w

Frames/ art is suggested to be no smaller than

11x 14 (this is based on display to be seen from a distance)

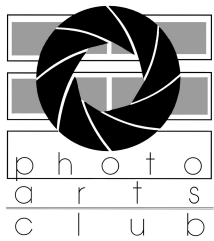
Frames must have wire attached to the back for proper hanging.

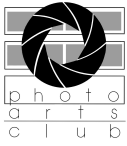
